

Gourmandizing NEON

This October, get hungry for "Lunchtime in Norfolk," a mural project that's been in the oven for months. Last spring, The Governor's School for the Arts public art students researched what and how Norfolkians ate over the centuries, uncovering unusual and beloved recipes, anecdotes and foodie advice. The rich material they digested is about to turn into a 70-foot mural on the side of Virginia Furniture on Olney Road painted by the art students and London-based artist Matthew McGuiness. Matt's **Gourmandizing** murals synthesize personal histories of food with text-based graphic art, creating memorable works of art with many layers of delicious meaning. Catch Matt and the kids painting for the next few weeks, with the big reveal during NEON Festival on October 21 with a ribbon-cutting and a special exhibition showcasing Gourmandizing at Commune NFK.



MIGHTY DREAM

This fall, Pharrell Williams launches MIGHTY DREAM, a multi-day forum right here in Norfolk, Virginia where matters of business, opportunity and money will intersect with people of color, set against a backdrop of community engagement and jaw-dropping entertainment. With conference events throughout downtown Norfolk and on Norfolk State University's campus, attendees will experience the best of the 757's food, music and entertainment.

During prime end-of-the-work day hours on Wednesday, November 2, MIGHTY DREAM takes over key blocks of the NEON District to create a Business-focused Block Party - the vibes of a great street fest filled with local food and drinks, community organizations, and pop up talent with curated stages, vendor stands and food trucks that showcase small businesses. With tickets available for purchase as well as access for conference goers, the block party will provide more than 2,000 attendees an opportunity to directly connect with joy.
